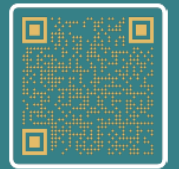
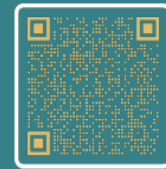

Nicene Creed
