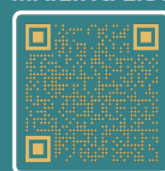

He reminds us that it is not possible to fulfil the obligation for the two days (The Assumption and the usual Sunday) by attending a vigil Mass on Saturday. Two separate Masses must be attended.



He also mentions that a vigil Mass on Friday evening will fulfil the obligation. Consequently we will have a special Vigil Mass on Friday, 14th August.

Please remember that attendance is absolutely necessary at Mass on the two Holy Days of Obligation (Christmas and the Assumption).

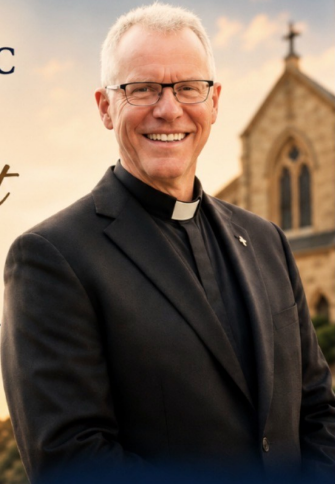

Celebrating First Holy Communion



First Holy Communion will be celebrated on Sunday, 20th September at the 10am Mass at St Patrick's Church Bondi Beach. This is one of the greatest moments in a child's life, an unforgettable experience of closeness of God.

PREPARATION PROGRAMME

A four-week consecutive programme of instruction is necessary. Parent/guardian must attend together with their child for all four sessions.

The four sessions will be held at 6:30pm in St Anne's Parish Hall (Oakley Road entrance) on:

- Tuesday 1st September,
- Tuesday 8th September, and
- Tuesday 15th Sept^r

REQUIREMENTS

To receive First Holy Communion, a child must be baptised, have received the Sacrament of Penance in the Catholic Church, and be in Year 3 or above.

Gospel

Matthew 14:13-21

A reading from the holy Gospel according to Matthew

When Jesus received the news of John the Baptist's death he withdrew by boat to a lonely place where they could be by themselves. But the people heard of this and, leaving the towns, went after him on foot. So as he stepped ashore he saw a large crowd; and he took pity on them and healed their sick.

When evening came, the disciples went to him and said, 'This is a lonely place, and the time has slipped by; so send the people away, and they can go to the villages to buy themselves some food.' Jesus replied, 'There is no need for them to go: give them something to eat yourselves.' But they answered, 'All we have with us is five loaves and two fish.' 'Bring them here to me,' he said. He gave orders that the people were to sit down on the grass; then he took the five loaves and the two fish, raised his eyes to heaven and said the blessing. And breaking the loaves he handed them to his disciples who gave them to the crowds. They all ate as much as they wanted, and they collected the scraps remaining, twelve baskets full. Those who ate numbered about five thousand men, to say nothing of women and children.
